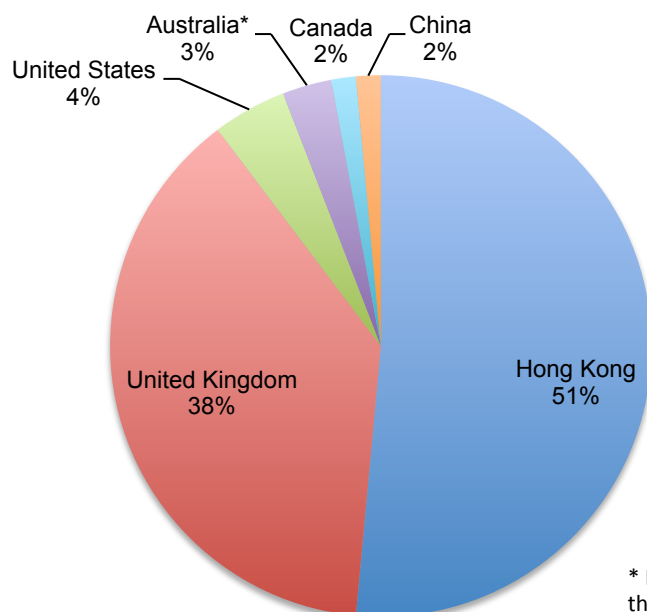


Class of 2015 Education Destinations

Destinations

80% of students pursuing their tertiary education are placed at the top 400 universities worldwide, based on the 2014/15 Times Higher Education Supplement's World University Rankings. Many universities have recognized their excellent achievement in the IB Diploma and reduced the number of credits of years students need to study to complete their degrees. Some of our students receive awards ranging from partial to full scholarships to support their tertiary education. Others have the opportunity to study an additional year to obtain a Master's degree.

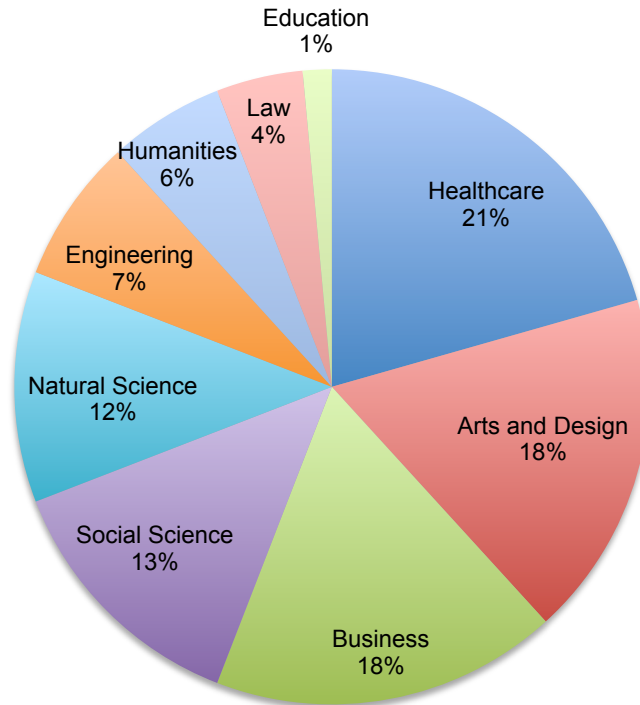
