

CKY IB Diploma May 2016 Preliminary Results

Po Leung Kuk CKY School is delighted to announce the 2016 IB Diploma results attained by our cohort of 70 diploma students in Year 12. One candidate achieved the maximum of 45 points, and 20% of our candidates the excellent score of 40 points or above. 69 candidates received the IB Diploma, including 62 Bilingual Diploma recipients. The general overview of our students' achievement as published by IBO on 6th July 2016 is as follows:
