We are delighted to announce the 2017 IB Diploma results attained by our cohort of 64 students in Year 12 registered for the IB Diploma. One candidate achieved the maximum of 45 points, and 27% of our candidates the excellent score of 40 points or above. 100% of our diploma candidates received the IB Diploma, including 56 Bilingual Diploma recipients.
